Nursery Places

You can apply for your Nursery places for September 2023 for both 2 year old and 3 Year old places with us. Please let your friends know as well so they can join us in school.

Application forms can be collected from Razina in the office, or just pop in with your child's birth certificate.

Free School Meals

Your child may also be able to get free milk if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

You need to apply online with the DFE 'applying for free school meals'.

For each child eligible for a FSM, school receives extra funding which allows us to increase staffing in your child's class. This is increasing helpful when school budgets are struggling to keep up with all the increased costs there are, just like you are finding difficult at home.

In addition, Kirklees Council sometimes give additional vouchers out to families to help subsidize the additional costs during holiday time. Therefore, this Summer families who have applied for FSM will receive a voucher for £70.
